Installation and user's guide

This manual contains instructions for installing and using the IBM $^{\circ}$ USB 2.0 Portable CD-RW Drive.

Product description

This guide contains installation and usage information for the IBM USB 2.0 Portable CD-RW Drive.

The IBM USB 2.0 Portable CD-RW Drive is a slimline CD-R/RW drive that attaches quickly and conveniently to your IBM ThinkPad [®] computer through one simple connection. The drive functions as a USB 1.1 device when connected to a USB 1.1 port and as a USB 2.0 device when connected to the USB 2.0 port. A maximum write speed of 4x to 6x is obtained through the USB 1.1 port. A maximum write speed of 8x is obtained through the USB 2.0 port.

Hardware and software requirements

You must have the following hardware installed on your ThinkPad computer in order to use this option:

- Diskette drive (for driver installation on Microsoft $^{\circ}$ Windows 98 $^{\circ}$ systems only)
- An available USB 1.1 or 2.0 port

Your computer must have one of the following operating systems installed to use this option:

- Microsoft Windows 98
- Microsoft Windows Millennium Edition (Me)
- Microsoft Windows 2000 Professional

• Microsoft Windows XP

Software description

This section describes the read/write capabilities of the IBM USB 2.0 Portable CD-RW drive.

The IBM USB 2.0 Portable CD-RW drive can write to and read from CD-ReWritable (CD-RW) and CD-Recordable (CD-R) discs, and can read CD-ROM discs. To use the drive's CD-recording functions, you must install the included IBM CD-RW Application Software. This software allows you to create audio and data CDs and to copy CDs. For more information on using the software, please refer to the user's guide contained on the CD-RW Application software CD.

Using CD-R and CD-RW media

This section describes the types of media and write speeds used with your IBM USB 2.0 Portable CD-RW drive.

The drive can write to both CD-R and CD-RW discs. CD-R discs cannot be erased or overwritten but can be used with standard CD-ROM drives and audio CD players. CD-RW discs can be erased and rewritten, but can only be used with newer Multi-Read and CD-RW compatible CD-ROM and DVD-ROM drives.

The writing speed of the media is indicated on the package of the CD-R/RW media. When writing, write within the scope of the specified writing speed of the media used. Although higher speed media can be used, the maximum write speed is 8X when connected through the USB 2.0 port, and 4X-6X when connected through USB 1.1 port.

The read and write results of the drive depend upon the quality and characteristics of the CD-R and CD-RW media used. Poor results may be obtained with some CD-R and CD-RW suppliers.

Power management functions (Standby/Hibernate/Suspend/Resume)

This section describes the power management functions for the IBM USB 2.0 Portable CD-RW drive.

- For optimal results, do not use the suspend/standby function while the drive is in write operation. Data errors might occur.
- Do not connect or disconnect the drive while the computer is in the standby (suspend) mode. Your computer might become unstable.

Maintaining your drive

This section contains maintenance information for your IBM USB Portable 2.0 CD-RW Drive.

- Do not remove the ac adapter while the drive is in use
- Turn screensavers off using a screensaver may interrupt the formatting and writing process of CDs.
- Place the drive in a stable place without any vibration or tilt movement of the drive while formatting or writing a disc may cause data errors
- Handle the CD by the edges or the center hole do not touch the surface of the CD
- To remove dust or fingerprints, wipe the CD from the center to the edge with a soft, lint-free cloth do not wipe in a circular motion as this may cause data loss
- Do not use commercial cleaners to clean the CD
- Do not touch the internal lens of the CD-RW drive
- Remove any CD from the drive before transporting the drive
- Do not operate the drive under these conditions: high temperature, high humidity, direct sunlight, inclined surface, excessive vibration/shock, excessive dust, damp environment, or near liquids that may spill causing damage to the drive
- Do not stack objects on the drive

Details and functions

This section provides the details and functions of the IBM USB Portable 2.0 CD-RW Drive.







2 Disc tray

Set the media with the label face upward on this disc tray.

3 USB connector

Insert the plug of the provided dedicated USB cable.

4 DC-IN connector

Connect the provided dedicated ac adapter.

Be sure to connect the provided dedicated ac adapter to this connector. Never connect other ac adapters.

This drive cannot operate with only the bus power of the USB cable. Be sure to provide power by connecting the provided ac adapter.



The green LED indicates the power status and the operation states of the drive.

When the drive is connected to ac power and the USB port of your PC	Indicator light turns on
During data write	Indicator light turns on
During data read	Indicator blinks
When the drive is not connected to the USB port	Indicator light turns off

6 Write indicator

The amber light emitting-drive (LED) indicates the write state of the drive.

During data write	Indicator blinks
Modes other than the above	Indicator light turns off

7 Eject button

Press the eject button to open the top cover.

An electrical locking mechanism is used in this drive so that an erroneous operation does not open the top cover during write. Make sure that the power is on and the drive is not in operation before pressing the eject button to open the top cover.

If the top cover cannot be opened even when the eject button is pressed or if the top cover needs to be opened when power is not supplied form the ac adapter, use the emergency eject lever at the bottom of the drive.

8 Line output jack

Connect this jack to the line input signal of your computer (using the included audio cable) when outputting the audio signal from this drive.

In some operating systems the audio cable is not requred. Audio can be achieved by the following steps:

1. Double-click My Computer.

- 2. Select the **USB 2.0 Portable CD-RW drive**. (For example, select *e*, where e represents the drive letter of the CD-RW drive.
- 3. Click Properties -> Hardware -> IBM CD-RW USB 2.0 USB Device.
- 4. Click Properites and then select the Properties tab.
- 5. Select Enable digital CD audio for this CD-ROM device.
- 6. Click OK.

9 Emergency eject lever

When ejecting the media with the power off, insert a thin metal rod such as a paper clip into the emergency eject lever and slide it in the direction of the arrow shown.

Connecting the CD-RW drive to your computer

This section provides information to connect the IBM USB 2.0 Portable CD-RW Drive to your computer.

Follow these instructions to connect the CD-RW drive:

- 1. Locate the USB cable included with this option. One connector on the USB cable is smaller than the other and has two small buttons on each side.
- 2. Squeeze the two buttons on the smaller connector and attach that end of the USB cable to the USB connector on the back of the CD-RW drive.



Make sure that the metal plate on the smaller connector is facing up when you plug it into the USB connector on the CD-RW drive.

- 3. Plug the larger end of the USB cable into the USB port on your computer.
- 4. Connect the power adapter to the drive and to the wall outlet.
- Optional Power Sharing Device used when the user would like to power the IBM USB 2.0 Portable CD-RW drive using the ThinkPad 56W, 72W ac, or 72 dc power adapters.

Installing the device drivers

This section provides information on installing device drivers to your computer.

To install the device driver, follow the instructions that correspond to your operating system.

Installing the device driver for Windows 98

- 1. After you have connected the CD-RW drive in your computer, turn on your computer if it is not already on. A popup window will open.
- 2. In the New Hardware wizard for IBM USB Portable CD-RW Drive window, click **Next**.
- 3. Select the Search for the best driver for your device check box.
- 4. Insert the *IBM USB Portable CD-RW Drive Option diskette* into your diskette drive.
- 5. Select the **diskette drive** check box.
- 6. Click Next twice.
- 7. Click Finish to complete the device driver installation.

You can now use the CD-RW drive with Windows 98.

Installing the device driver for Windows Me, Windows 2000, and Windows XP

The USB device driver is included in Windows Me, Windows 2000, and Windows XP operating systems. When this drive is connected, Windows will automatically install the appropriate device driver and the drive will be ready to be used. You do not have to perform any special installation or un-installation.

Disconnecting and reconnecting the CD-RW drive

This section provides information on disconnecting and reconnecting your IBM USB 2.0 Portable CD-RW Drive.

Hot plugging is supported on the connection between the USB cable and your computer. This means that the CD-RW drive USB cable can be disconnected from and reconnected to your computer without the need to restart the computer.

Follow these instructions to disconnect the drive:

- 1. Close the program that is using the drive.
- 2. Confirm that the WRITE and BUSY indicator of the drive are off.
- **3**. Click the **Remove (Unplug or Eject Hardware)** icon . (By default this icon is located next to clock display in the taskbar).
- 4. Select the USB 2.0 CD-RW drive to remove.
- 5. The Remove Hardware confirmation message displays. Click OK.
- 6. Remove the plug of the USB cable from the USB port of the computer.
- 7. To reconnect, plug the USB cable into the USB port of the computer.

Attention

Do not disconnect and reconnect the USB cable in rapid succession or the CD-ROM drive might not load properly. After disconnecting the USB cable, wait at least 10 to 20 seconds, or until the hourglass icon stops displaying, before reconnecting the USB cable.

Installations- und Benutzerhandbuch

Produktbeschreibung

Das vorliegende Handbuch enthält Informationen zur Installation und Verwendung des tragbaren IBM USB 2.0 CD-RW-Laufwerks.

Beim tragbaren IBM USB 2.0 CD-RW-Laufwerk handelt es sich um ein flaches CD-R/RW-Laufwerk, das schnell und bequem über einen einfachen Anschluss an den IBM ThinkPad[®] angeschlossen werden kann. Das Laufwerk wird beim Anschluss an einen USB 1.1-Anschluss als USB 1.1-Einheit eingesetzt und beim Anschluss an einen USB 2.0-Anschluss als USB 2.0-Einheit. Über den USB 1.1-Anschluss wird bei Schreibvorgängen eine maximale Übertragungsgeschwindigkeit von 4x bis 6x erreicht. Über den USB 2.0-Anschluss wird bei Schreibvorgängen eine maximale Übertragungsgeschwindigkeit von 8x erreicht.

Beschreibung der Software

Im folgenden Abschnitt werden die Funktionen bei den Lese-/Schreibvorgängen des tragbaren IBM USB 2.0 CD-RW-Laufwerks beschrieben.

Mit dem tragbaren IBM USB 2.0 CD-RW-Laufwerk können CD-RWs und CD-Rs (CD-Recordable) beschrieben und gelesen und CD-ROMs gelesen werden. Damit die CD-Aufzeichnungsfunktionen des Laufwerks verwendet werden können, müssen Sie die beigefügte IBM CD-RW-Anwendungssoftware installieren. Mit dieser Software können Sie Audio- und Daten-CDs erstellen und CDs kopieren. Weitere Informationen zur Verwendung der Software finden Sie im Benutzerhandbuch, das sich auf der CD mit der CD-RW-Anwendungssoftware befindet.

CD-R- und CD-RW-Datenträger verwenden

In diesem Abschnitt werden die Arten von Datenträgern beschrieben, die in Verbindung mit dem tragbaren IBM USB 2.0 CD-RW-Laufwerk verwendet werden können, sowie die möglichen Übertragungsgeschwindigkeiten bei Schreibvorgängen.

Mit dem Laufwerk können sowohl CD-Rs als auch CD-RWs beschrieben werden. CD-Rs können nicht gelöscht oder überschrieben, jedoch in Standard-CD-ROM-Laufwerken und Audio-CD-Spielern verwendet werden. CD-RWs können gelöscht und erneut beschrieben, jedoch nur in neueren MR- und CD-RWkompatiblen CD-ROM- und DVD-ROM-Laufwerken verwendet werden.

Die Übertragungsgeschwindigkeit bei Schreibvorgängen ist auf der Verpackung des CD-R/RW-Datenträgers angegeben. Bei Schreibvorgängen sollte der Bereich der angegebenen Übertragungsgeschwindigkeit für den verwendeten Datenträger eingehalten werden. Es können zwar Datenträger mit höherer Übertragungsgeschwindigkeit verwendet werden, die normale Übertragungsgeschwindigkeit bei Schreibvorgängen beträgt jedoch 8x beim Anschluss über den USB 2.0-Anschluss und 4x bis 6x beim Anschluss über den USB 1.1-Anschluss.

Die Ergebnisse der Lese- und Schreibvorgänge des Laufwerks richten sich nach der Qualität und den Merkmalen des verwendeten CD-R- und CD-RW-Datenträgers. Bei einigen CD-R- und CD-RW-Herstellern sind die erzielten Ergebnisse möglicherweise schlecht.

Stromsparfunktionen (Standby/Hibernation/Aussetzen/Wiederaufnehmen)

Im folgenden Abschnitt werden die Stromsparfunktionen des tragbaren IBM USB 2.0 CD-RW-Laufwerks beschrieben.

- Verwenden Sie die Funktion "Aussetzen" bzw. "Standby" nicht, wenn auf dem Laufwerk ein Schreibvorgang läuft, da sonst die Ergebnisse nicht optimal sind. In diesem Fall können Datenfehler auftreten.
- Schließen Sie das Laufwerk nicht an bzw. trennen Sie es nicht, wenn sich der Computer im Standby-Modus (Aussetzmodus) befindet. Der Betrieb des Computers kann sonst instabil sein.

Laufwerk verwalten

Der folgende Abschnitt enthält Informationen zur Verwaltung des tragbaren IBM USB 2.0 CD-RW-Laufwerks.

- Entfernen Sie das Netzteil nicht, wenn das Laufwerk in Betrieb ist.
- Schalten Sie Bildschirmschoner aus, da sonst möglicherweise der Formatierund Schreibprozess der CDs unterbrochen wird.
- Stellen Sie das Laufwerk auf eine stabile Unterlage, die keinen Erschütterungen ausgesetzt ist bzw. die keine Neigung aufweist, da jede Bewegung des Laufwerks während des Formatierens oder Beschreibens eines Datenträgers Datenfehler verursachen kann.
- Berühren Sie eine CD nur am Rand oder am Loch in der Mitte; berühren Sie nicht die Oberfläche der CD.
- Entfernen Sie Staub oder Fingerabdrücke von einer CD, indem Sie sie mit einem weichen, fusselfreien Tuch von innen nach außen abwischen; wischen Sie nicht in einer kreisenden Bewegung, da dabei Daten verloren gehen können.
- Reinigen Sie CDs nicht mit gewöhnlichen Reinigern.
- Vermeiden Sie es, die Linse im Innern des CD-RW-Laufwerks zu berühren.
- Entfernen Sie vor einem Transportieren des Laufwerks eventuell darin enthaltene CDs.
- Nehmen Sie das Laufwerk unter folgenden Bedingungen nicht in Betrieb: hohe Temperatur, hohe Luftfeuchtigkeit, direktes Sonnenlicht, geneigter Untergrund, übermäßige Erschütterungen/Stöße, übermäßiger Staub, feuchte Umgebung oder in der Nähe von Flüssigkeiten, die beim Verschütten das Laufwerk beschädigen können.
- Stellen Sie keine Gegenstände auf dem Laufwerk ab.

7 Entnahmetaste

Drücken Sie die Entnahmetaste, um die obere Abdeckung zu öffnen.

In diesem Laufwerk wird ein elektrischer Sperrmechanismus verwendet, so dass bei bei fehlerhaftem Betrieb die obere Abdeckung während eines Schreibvorgangs nicht geöffnet wird. Der Strom muss eingeschaltet sein, und das Laufwerk darf nicht in Betrieb sein, wenn die Entnahmetaste zum Öffnen der oberen Abdeckung gedrückt wird.

Wenn die obere Abdeckung durch Drücken der Entnahmetaste nicht geöffnet werden kann oder wenn die obere Abdeckung geöffnet werden muss, wenn kein Netzstrom über das Netzteil vorhanden ist, müssen Sie den Notentnahmehebel an der Unterseite des Laufwerks verwenden.

8 Ausgangsanschluss

Schließen Sie diesen Anschluss an das Eingangssignal des Computers (unter Verwendung des beigefügten Audiokabels) an, wenn das Tonsignal über den Ausgang des Laufwerks ausgegeben wird.

Bei einigen Betriebssystemen ist das Audiokabel nicht erforderlich. Führen Sie für die Audioausgabe die folgenden Schritte aus:

- 1. Klicken Sie doppelt auf My Computer.
- 2. Wählen Sie **USB 2.0 Portable CD-RW drive** aus. (Wählen Sie z. B. *e* aus, wobei "e" für den Laufwerkbuchstaben des CD-RW-Laufwerks steht.
- 3. Klicken Sie auf Properties -> Hardware -> IBM CD-RW USB 2.0 USB Device.

- 5. Wählen Sie Enable digital CD audio for this CD-ROM device aus.
- 6. Klicken Sie auf OK.
