## New information about your Netfinity 5000

This Technical Update contains the following new information about your Netfinity 5000 server:

- RAID microcode update
- S3 video driver update

## RAID microcode update

You must upgrade your RAID adapter microcode prior to installing the operating system on your Netfinity server if you have one of the following adapters installed:

- IBM ServeRAID-3H Ultra2 SCSI Adapter with the IBM ServeRAID-3H 32 MB/Battery-Backup Cache: use the microcode version 3.11 or later.
- IBM ServeRAID II Ultra SCSI Adapter with the IBM ServeRAID II 8 MB/Battery-Backup Cache: use the microcode version 2.88 or later.
